FLAG Works, Inc. sponsors the North American Chemical Residue Workshop (NACRW) formerly the Florida Pesticide Residue Workshop (FPRW) which conducts an annual meeting for scientists particularly interested in trace level analysis of pesticides, veterinary drug residues, and other chemicals in food, animal feed, and environmental samples. The purpose of the meeting is to provide training, develop and improve technical knowledge, facilitate development and distribution of new analysis methods and techniques, and establish networking to promote professional cooperation between scientists of these interests. While the majority of attendees are from North America, important international speakers are always included in the Technical Program, and attendance of scientists from Asia, Europe, South America, Australia, and Africa is increasing annually. The meeting is expected to have approximately 300 to 350 attendees representing government, academia, and industries.

We are pleased to announce that we will be offering this year five student stipends where undergraduate and graduate students can apply and if chosen will receive a \$500 stipend for travel to the NACRW 2016 conference.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate or graduate research in the area of analysis of pesticides, veterinary drug residues, chemicals in food, animal feed and environmental samples
- Student must be directly involved in the research
- Submit a 250 words or less abstract describing the work on-line at www.nacrw.org
- Abstract submission will open on January 11, 2016 and close on April 20, 2016.
- Abstracts will be reviewed and judged by the Program Committee

- Students chosen for the award will be notified by date May 9, 2016.
- Students awarded the stipend must participate in the NACRW 2016 conference
- Students awarded the stipend will present their work in a poster during the poster session
- Students are encouraged to participate in the NACRW conference, presentations, social event and networking opportunities
